Exit Games integrates IP Multimedia Subsystem (IMS) into its multiplayer platform, helping network operators to access new target groups for 3G products

As part of its 3G initiative, Exit Games, the service provider for interactive mobile entertainment, has joined the Siemens IMS Developer Program. The integration of IMS enables Exit Games to equip its multiplayer developer platform for mobile games, Exit Games Neutron, with additional innovative features. These features mean that mobile telephone operators and mobile entertainment developers will be able to bring even more appealing 3G products onto the market in future.

On this year's 3G World Congress in Hong Kong, Exit Games will be announcing details of its 3G Initiative 2006, which will enable latest-generation mobile games with broadband data (such as video), real-time latency and extensive social communication and interactive features.

Network operators will then be able to better use the entertainment potential of their 3G networks and access new and younger target group segments.
